

MAMP Ethics Committee Duties & Responsibilities

- 1. Periodically review and revise MAMP's Code of Ethics & Best Lending Practices and the Enforcement Policies & Procedures.**
- 2. Assist state affiliates in the implementation of their Enforcement Procedures for the Code of Ethics and Professional Standards/Best Lending Practices**
- 3. Establish policies and procedures for MAMP to use in conjunction with complaints of Ethics, Professional Standards/Best Lending Practices violations involving members of its:**
 - a. Board of Directors as an entity**
 - b. Committee Members, or**
 - c. Any Volunteer who is representing MAMP**
- 4. Monitor state affiliates' compliance with MAMP Ethics & Professional Standards/Best Lending Practices Enforcement Policies.**
- 5. Interface with other MAMP committees in communicating to sources outside the Association, the efforts of MAMP in the enforcement of these policies & procedures.**
- 6. Others, as identified by committee on-going.**
